Division Council Meetings. Team 2007-2008 will continue the long-standing tradition of monthly council meetings. These meetings, commonly referred to as “DCM's” (Division Council Meetings) provide an opportunity for the lieutenant governor to work with club presidents and division leaders to address common club concerns; evaluate progress in achieving club, division, and district goals; resolve minor club problems before they become serious; track report filings; promote club, division, district, and International programs; and coordinate implementation of division-wide projects and events such as the district governor's visit and the building of a new Kiwanis club. It also allows for club presidents to share their ideas and successes with their peers and for club presidents to be briefed on division coordinators duties and areas of responsibility.

DCM Attendees. Council membership includes the lieutenant governor, lieutenant governor elect, immediate past lieutenant governor, division appointees, and all club presidents and club secretaries. Past district officers, past lieutenant governors, and the lieutenant governors or representatives of Circle K, KIWIN, and Key Club are always invited to attend these DCM's. Kiwanians from all Division 37 clubs are encouraged to attend. New members and guests are also always welcome.

Meeting Schedule. Meetings are normally scheduled for the first Saturday of each month beginning promptly at 9:15 am and are regularly scheduled to conclude not later than 10:30 am. Division 37 clubs host the DCM.

Pre-DCM Briefing. Immediately prior to the DCM, division coordinators and chairs of division projects are asked to brief the lieutenant governor at a pre-DCM briefing beginning at 8:15 am. Division coordinators and chairs of division projects who brief the lieutenant governor are asked to also attend the DCM and share the information with the club presidents. While
